One way to accomplish this is through IMPACT, an annual event, hosting over 200 churches each year. The conference features multiple speakers; provide adult and student training sessions as well as entertainment. This year's conference will feature worship band *Daniel's Window* and a Saturday night concert with national recording band *Skillet*.

Of course there is a cost to attend the conference. Last year we commuted back and forth daily and found it to be a bit challenging and tiring on all of us. This year we are making arrangements to stay in the area for two nights. The church once again is paying the registration fee for all SonLife youth and adult leaders.

SHINE program starts with 5 great participants in first class

The SHINE program (Staying Healthy in Nutrition and Exercise) is off to a great start with two weeks (six sessions) already finished for the five initial students.

Program Director Estrella Knutson, says "thank you to everyone who helped to get us to this point. There was the painting, cleaning, unpacking equipment, registration, designing and handing out brochures...the list could go on."

"The participants," said Estrella, "are committed and wonderfully diverse. They range in age from 8 to 13 years old. The sessions begin with prayer and a praise dance lead by Sally Choquette.

The program then moves into the circuit room for some challenging muscle training and aerobic work. The equipment is built in such a way that Sally and Estrella both go through the circuit with the students. (Yes, they get as much of a workout as they do). The sessions end with a short "huddle" time and prayer. Everyone leaves tired, sweaty, and red-faced, but smiling. It is so neat to see the Lord at work.

Support has been wonderful. In the words of one of the participants, "Is it time to praise the Lord yet?"
